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**Providence Regional Cancer Partnership Receives National Outstanding Achievement Award from
American College of Surgeons' Commission on Cancer**

*Award recognizes cancer programs that achieve excellence
in providing highest quality care to people with cancer.*

Everett, Wash. (May 12, 2014) — Providence Regional Cancer Partnership (Cancer Partnership) was recently presented with the 2013 Outstanding Achievement Award by the American College of Surgeons' Commission on Cancer. The Cancer Partnership is one of only two cancer programs in Washington State to receive the award, and one of a select group of 74 accredited U.S. cancer programs to be recognized. The award is given to cancer programs that achieve excellence in providing quality care to people with cancer.

“This award is assurance to patients that the Cancer Partnership provides the highest quality of care for all their cancer needs. This excellence in care goes beyond the four walls of the facility and represents the surgeons, specialists, primary care providers, nurses and other healthcare professionals within our medical community,” said Elie Saikaly, MD, MMM, medical director at the Cancer Partnership.

The Cancer Partnership was evaluated on 34 program standards categorized within one of five cancer program activity areas: quality improvement, clinical services, cancer conferences, data management and committee leadership. The program demonstrated a commendation level of compliance on seven standards representing four areas of program management, clinical services, patient outcomes and data quality. In addition, it received a compliant rating in all other categories.
